Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12 Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by elaw subject to availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension
2	The school does not have the ramp at the main entrance of the school building and has constructed a ramp to access the upper floors, but it is appearing to be steep and does not seem to be navigable by a wheelchair-bound student/staff. Thus, the school is required to dis-mantle the said ramp and re-construed the same to access upper floors and on ground level with proper incline and safety features as per RPWD Act-2016 and Board's guidelines, within 03 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal.
3	All science labs are appearing to be temporarily arranged and not as per the SoP. The school is required to set-up the composite science lab with permanent fixtures, washbasin, water and gas connection in the workstation, proper storage, seating arrangement and safety features such as fire extinguisher and exhaust fan within 03 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal.
4	The school is required to upgrade the mathematics lab with proper storage and seating arrangement, within 03 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal.

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5	Details of the lessor/ owner of the land is not mentioned in the land certificate. Thus, the school is required to obtain the revised land certificate with complete details of lessor and lessee as per format i.e. appendix – X as prescribed in circular no. 12/2022 within 03 months and submit the certificate in the compliance on SARAS Portal.
6	The school is required to appoint qualified Lab assistant and constituted the Sexual Harassment Committee as per norms within 03 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal
7	The school is required to submit the complete staff statement along with their qualifications and appointment letters within 03 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal.
8	The washrooms are dirty with broken tiles. Many doors of class rooms and toilets need cementing. Peeling paint is seen in many places. The school shall remove all these deficiencies and improve the maintenance of campus within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
9	The CWSN toilets are seen with rusted support bars with sharp edges which are not safe for students. The school shall replace them with moveable grab rods on both sides of WC and provide a wash basin inside the CWSN toilets as per guidelines issued by the Board with 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
10	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Noida within 3 months and submit the compliance on SARAS Portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty
